Consequently you can explore the extensive and ever expanding catalogue of images on this website. Pen and ink drawings with the addition of bright acrylic paint are the basic ingredients of David Crighton's art-making techniques. In addition to that he utilizes computer software to enhance the finished products by the insertion of custom lettering on various elements of the designs such as billboards and newsboxes. Corporate identities can be inserted in the form of company vehicles and logos. All the images on this site are available in any proportional size, larger as posters and smaller as notecards. Anything is possible.

The artworks represented on this website are printed on acid-free paper using archival quality inks upon which David adds significant touches of original colour by hand. The resulting limited edition prints are therefore each unique unto themselves. Some famous people are proud owners of Crighton artworks.

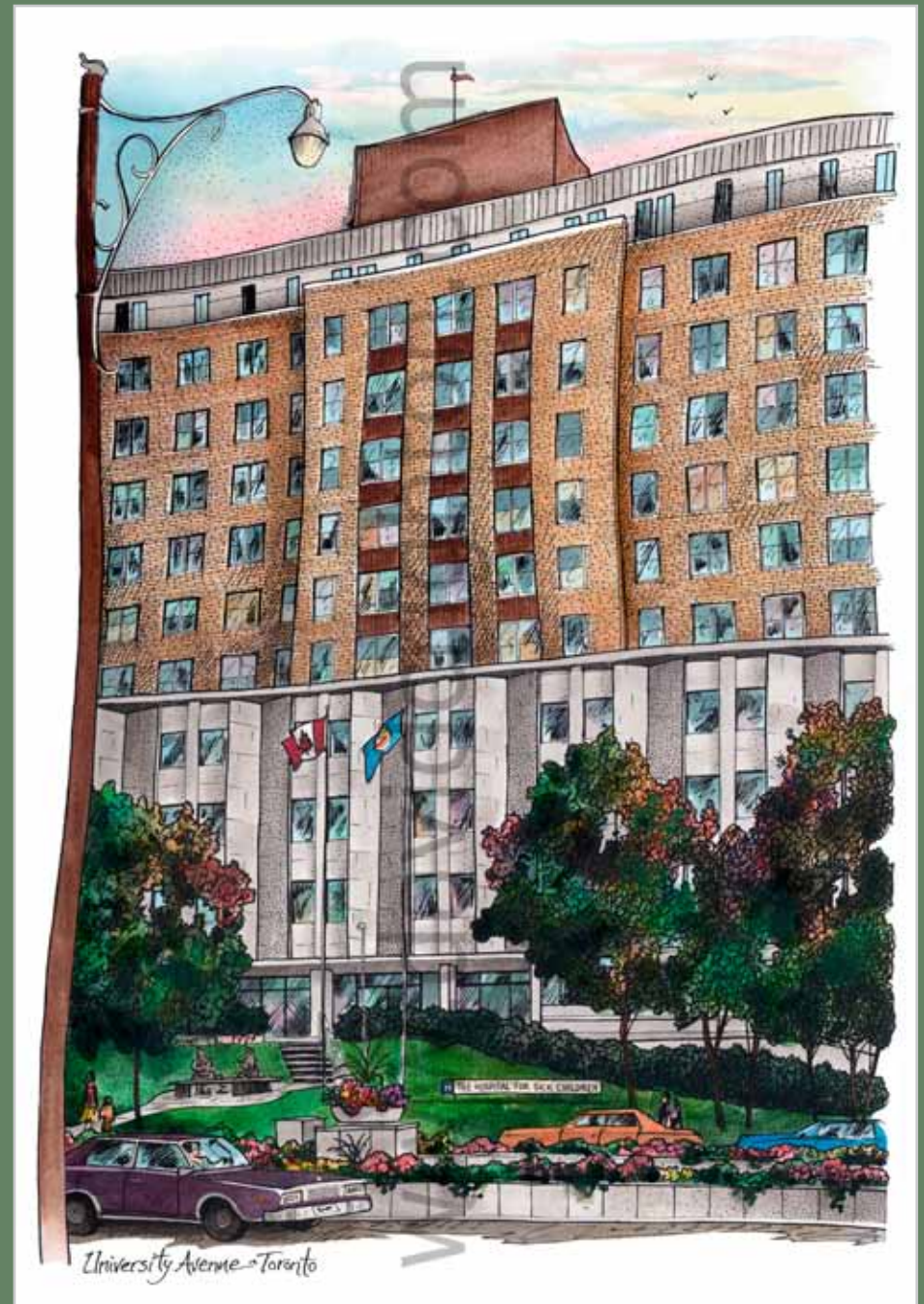
